

Dr Pascal Stammet

Biosketch

Dr Pascal Stammet is a medical doctor specialized in anesthesia and intensive care medicine currently working at the Intensive Care Unit at Centre Hospitalier de Luxembourg (CHL). He also served for nearly four years as medical and health director of the National Fire and Rescue Corps (“Corps Grand-ducal d’incendie et de secours”, CGDIS) before returning to the clinics. Since April 2024, he has been appointed clinical affiliated professor at the University of Luxembourg where he is also the director of the Bachelor of Medicine program. He did a PhD at Liège University, Belgium, on outcome prediction after cardiac arrest. Since more than 15 years his research focusses on cardiac arrest care to improve prognostication as well as treatment for these patients. He contributed to collaborative clinical and laboratory research within international networks as well as national research institutions like the Luxembourg Institute of Health and the University of Luxembourg. He contributed to more than 75 peer reviewed publications mostly on the topic of cardiac arrest care.
