Laetitia Garcia, PhD, is Clinical Research Coordinator for Regulatory & Quality at the Luxembourg Institute of Health, within the Clinical and Epidemiological Investigation Center. In this role, she oversees regulatory compliance and quality management for clinical and translational research activities, supporting investigators in the preparation and submission of regulatory dossiers to ethics committees and health authorities.

Her expertise covers the alignment of European frameworks (ICH-GCP, EU CTR 536/2014, MDR 2017/745, GDPR) with national and institutional requirements applicable to clinical research in Luxembourg. She contributes to the continuous improvement of LIH's internal quality management system, promotes early regulatory engagement, and fosters harmonised practices across investigator-initiated studies.

She holds a PhD in Biomedical and Pharmaceutical Sciences from the Université catholique de Louvain (Belgium). Her doctoral research explored antibiotic pharmacodynamics in cystic-fibrosis-associated infections, bridging microbiology and clinical relevance – a perspective that continues to guide her work on the ethical and regulatory translation of research into clinical practice.
