The Luxembourg Research Clinic (Fuerschungsklinik Lëtzebuerg; LRC) is a national initiative bringing together Luxembourg's four hospitals, the Luxembourg Institute of Health (LIH), and the University of Luxembourg to strengthen clinical and translational research for the benefit of patients.

Its purpose is not to operate as a separate hospital, but to bring a functional clinical research infrastructure into the existing system of medical care. By creating the conditions for more research studies and clinical trials to take place in Luxembourg, it gives patients better access to medical innovation and supports the development of future diagnostics, treatments, and prevention approaches.

By connecting hospitals, research institutions, and academic teaching, the Luxembourg Research Clinic helps make clinical research more coordinated, accessible, and effective across the country. It focuses on priority health areas such as cancer, neurology, immunity and infection, paediatric and rare diseases, cardiovascular and preventive care, and mental health.

Through shared research support, data and study infrastructures, and dedicated funding for clinical research projects, the Luxembourg Research Clinic aims to improve patient outcomes, strengthen medical research and training, and reinforce Luxembourg's role in health innovation.

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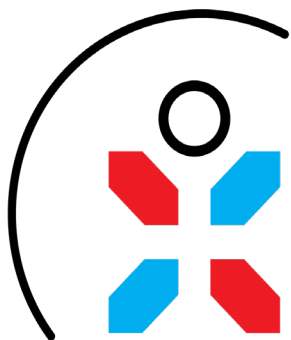
