Prior to joining LIH in 2018, he was Programme Officer for Biomedical Research at the Luxembourg National Research Fund (FNR), leading several national strategic initiatives, including the FNR Foresight Study and the implementation of the National Centre of Excellence pilot programme in Parkinson's disease. He also served as Coordinator of the Clinnova project, leading an international consortium that secured Horizon 2020 funding to develop a Centre of Excellence in Digital Health and Personalised Medicine.

As Coordinator of the Clinnova project, he led a Luxembourgish, Danish, and German consortium that successfully obtained Horizon 2020 support for the development of a Centre of Excellence in Digital Health and Personalised Medicine. He has also contributed to several European Joint Programming Initiatives and ERA-NET programmes, including ERA-NET SysBio, ERA-NET Neuron, and ERA-NET Neuron II.
